




A. Remove old door.








2. Remove Door Stops.




3. Remove Door Casing.



D. Install Bookshelf Door Frame into the Door Entrance.




I. Insert the Bookshelf Door Frame into your door entrance.

* By this point, your door entrance should NOT have Door Stops and Door Casing.





2. Place screws on the side frame of your door, so it attaches to your existing door frame.



3. If the wall or your existing rough opening or door frame is not leveled or straight, you will need to shim the door to level it.

E. Attach the Bookcase to the Bookshelf Door Frame.





I. Place the Bookcase in position by aligning the bottom shaft into the Rotating Pivot Mechanism.

A CAUTION!

Two people are required for this whole part of the installation process.

2. This part required the help of another person. Remember the Bookshelf Doors can be heavy!




Work with one Bookcase at the time.

3. Align the upper Bookcase Pin Hole with the Frame Hole and insert the Pin by pushing the Pin Bottom. Repeat this process for the other Bookcase.

F. Make Final Adjustments.







I. If, after installation, you encounter a gap between the Top Casing and the Middle Casing. You will need to unscrew the Middle Casing from behind and lift it until the gap disappears. Then attach the Middle Casing back to the Bookshelf Door by screwing it in place. (At times, you may be required to nail in the casing if your door doesn't have screws.)

Place Upper Trim back by screwing it to seal the gap between Top Casing and Bookcase.

G. Installing features.







I. If your Bookshelf Door has Bottom Cabinets and you ordered cabinet hardware, now is the time to install them.

2. If you ordered a Back Door Casing, now is the time to install it! We recomend to work with one piece at the time and have a layout plan before you start screwing the Back Casing in the Wall

3. If you ordered your Bookshelf Door with Mirror behind. Never face the mirror down or put preassure.

Lock Mechanism

4. For an easy installation experience, we send all our Lock Mechanisms already installed to the Bookshelf Door.

TROUBLE SHOOTING

In case your door does not lock, we recomand the following:

Check to make sure the wires are securely tightened to the correct terminal block Check that the power supply is connected and operating properly Make sure the lock switch is wired correctly



Maderra recommends a licensed and trained electrician whenever wiring is involved.
